

DETAILS OF FAMILARISATION PROGRAMMES FOR INDEPENDENT DIRECTORS FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2018-19

The Board is regularly updated on the significant changes in laws and regulations and periodic presentations are made on business and performance updates of the Company.

- a) Presentation providing familiarisation of the changes brought in by amendments in Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Regulations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 majority provisions effective from April 1, 2019;
- b) Presentation on amendment in SEBI (Prohibition of Insider Trading) Regulations, 2015 where majority of provisions are effective from April 1, 2019
